

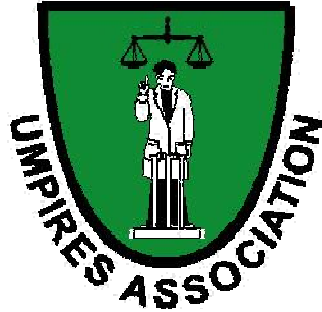

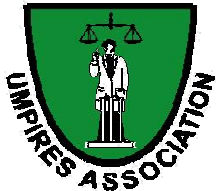

# FLORIDA CRICKET UMPIRES ASSOCIATION

## CODE OF CONDUCT

### PREFACE

**This Code is a supplement to the Constitution of the Florida Cricket Umpires Association and shall be utilized in conjunction with the said Constitution. The Rules of Natural Justice shall apply and consist of (1) The right to a fair hearing and (2) The rule against bias.**

1. Members must be properly attired for all games. (a) The required outfit will be determined by the Executive. (b) The Executive can determine required outfit as they see necessary or when required by the governing body.
2. Umpires shall at all times conduct themselves in a manner in keeping with the spirit and tradition of the Game of Cricket and, shall maintain the highest standards of honesty and integrity while officiating at cricket matches or, when representing the Association.
3. Umpires and Officials of the Association shall not at any time engage in conduct unbecoming of an umpire which could bring the Game of Cricket or the Association into disrepute.
  - (a) Umpires shall work as a team and shall not criticize the actions or decisions of a colleague in public at any time.
  - (b) Umpires and Officials of the Association shall not comment, show dissent or use words to undermine the confidence of other umpires.
  - (c) Umpires and Officials shall not comment on any alleged breach of the Code or on any hearing or decision arising from such breach.
4. Umpires and Officials of the Association shall not use abusive or insulting language or make offensive gestures on or off the field or in the vicinity of cricket matches when a colleague is officiating.
5. Umpires shall not engage in the consumption of alcohol prior to or during Cricket matches or use illegal drugs or, directly or indirectly become involved in betting or gambling of any form on the outcome of the cricket match.
  - (a) The use of alcohol or drugs create the potential for serious injury and also the possibility that rational judgment could be impaired.
6. Umpires shall maintain the highest standards of professional competence and attend refresher training each year in order to be kept appraised of the changes approved to the laws of Cricket.
7. Umpires are required to submit a match report within forty-eight (48) hours after the match.
  - (a) Match reports are mandatory for all scheduled matches, played or not.
  - (b) Failure to comply could result in disciplinary action.
8. Umpires are expected to be familiar with the Rules of Play for Competitions.
  - (a) The Competition Rules takes precedence over any other Rules or Laws of Cricket.
  - (b) They must be adhered to unconditionally. (c) They are non-negotiable even if both captains agree to the change.
9. Should there be an infraction by any member or associate, the eligibility for reporting the breach of this Code must be in writing to the Secretary. (a) The report can be submitted by the team manager. (b) The Executive Officers of the cricket authority whose clubs are in such competition. (c) Any member of the Association.
10. Any member whose is accused has the right to a fair hearing.
  - (a) The right to a fair hearing requires that an individual shall not be penalized by a decision affecting his / her rights or legitimate expectations unless he has been given prior notice of the case against him, a fair opportunity to answer it and the opportunity to present his own case.
  - (b) Each individual must have the opportunity to present his/her version of the facts and to make submissions on the relevant principles of the Code of Conduct and the allegations against him/her.
11. Umpires and Officials of the Association shall honor the decisions of the committee or person appointed by the Executive Committee to adjudicate an allegation or allegations. (a) The decision is final. (b) Umpires or Officials of the Association shall not make any public announcement or media comments which are detrimental to the Umpires or the Association in regards to decisions.

***The Code of Conduct was developed by the Executive of the Association because of a profound belief that Umpires must maintain a sense of responsibility and dignity in the eyes of cricketers and spectators alike in keeping our motto: Honesty, Integrity and Commitment.....September 2007.***
